## 2022 New London Waterford Speedbowl Tire Policy

Note: This is subject to change based on tire supply

## Tire Inventory guidelines:

- All 6 regular Saturday divisions will have a managed Tire Inventory for the 2022 Season. Weekly purchase
  limits will follow the posted Tire Schedule. All weekly purchases limits will be based on tire availability
  from Hoosier Tire East and are subject to change.
- No tires can be purchased from Hoosier Tire East.
- Drivers MUST be registered with the New London Waterford Speedbowl to receive a tire coupon for the division they are competing in at each event. Tire inventory is assigned to the driver. No driver can be registered to multiple cars in the same division.
- The Driver must be signed in at the Handicappers Booth and your car on property to receive your Tire Coupon for the event, this includes any scheduled Open Practices. No one is allowed in the Hoosier Tire Compound without a Tire Coupon.
- If you do not purchase the allotted number of tires for a given week, you lose those tires from your inventory. There is NO "banking" of tires, this amount does not carry over to future events. You may register used tires in their place.
- Tires cannot be swapped between drivers as inventoried tires.
- ALL tires will be recorded on both the Tire Coupon and with the New London Waterford Speedbowl Tire
  Official. If no tires are purchased, you must state that on your coupon. Tires MUST be recorded prior to
  leaving the Tire Compound. The Tire Coupon will remain with the Tire Official after recording the
  numbers.
- Weekly tire purchase amounts for new competitors and existing competitors will be announced no later than the Thursday before the next event. This will be based off the availability from Hoosier Tire.
- Drivers MUST use tires that are in their inventory when competing in Qualifying and Feature Events.
- For some events drivers must use the same tires in both the Qualifying Event and Feature Event.

  Drivers will have their tires marked when in the qualifying lane and must start the feature event on the same tires.
- Drivers who purchase tires, but do not attempt to compete in practice, qualifying and feature events will lose future tire purchases. This will be monitored and reviewed after each event.
- All purchases are at the discretion of the Tire Official or Oval Track Operations Director. Any questions should be directed to them.
