

## **COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS:**

### **FACE MASKS | WASH HANDS | KEEP 6 FEET APART**

We have been working closely with Connecticut Government Officials and Waterford Town Officials to ensure New London Waterford Speedbowl will have a safe environment for all who attend. The following safety protocols and procedures will be in effect:

- **Covid Waiver:** In order to enter the facility, guests will be required to complete a one-time COVID-19 waiver form. Waiver forms will be available at sign in. The Covid Waiver Form is located in the main menu under the Forms tab on our website. Waiver forms can be downloaded and filled in prior to arriving at the Speedbowl. All employees and guests will be required to have their temperature taken prior to entry.
- **NO RE-ENTRY:** Once in the grandstand or paddock area, guests will not be allowed to exit and re-enter. (Considerations will be made for inclement weather and medical reasons. If there is a medical reason please see a staff member for assistance)
- **Social Distancing:**
  - Strict enforcement with the CDC-recommended 6' social distancing will be mandated throughout the property.
  - Guests are encouraged to limit the size of groups when seated in the grandstand area.
  - Guests can sit with family members or friends in the grandstand seating area but are encouraged to social distance from other individuals or groups.
  - Food and beverage areas will have designated lines with 6 foot social distance markings
  - **ALL ARE REQUIRED TO ADHERE TO THOSE GUIDELINES**
- **Personal Protective Equipment:**
  - All guests (ages 5 and up) are required to bring and wear face covering. No entry without face mask.
  - **Paddock Area:** Face masks are required at all times except when in your teams pit stall.
  - **General Admission Area and Midway:** Masks are required at all times.
  - **Grandstands:** Masks are recommended but not required when SITTING in grandstands and social distancing.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout our facility. Attendees are encouraged to wash hand frequently.
- New London Waterford Speedbowl will be cleaning and disinfecting restrooms and high touch areas throughout the events.
- **Bag Policy:** Due to the COVID-19 policies New London Waterford Speedbowl is no longer able to search bags, therefore we have updated our bag policy:
  - **Prohibited:**
    - ◆ Coolers
    - ◆ Backpacks
    - ◆ Non personal sized bags
  - **Allowed:**
    - ◆ Clear plastic or vinyl bags less than 12" X 12" X6"
    - ◆ 1 gallon clear plastic freezer bag
    - ◆ Personal sized purses and wallets

## **Ticket & Grandstand Policy:**

- No cash refunds, in the event of postponement tickets are good for a future event.
- For your safety and the safety of other, the following guidelines and rules are in effect at New London Waterford Speedbowl.
- **Bag Policy:** Please read general bag policy above.
- Personal chair backs are permitted with size restriction to a maximum seat depth of 12 inches
- The following items are not permitted for Security Reasons
  - Glass
  - Cans
  - Alcohol
  - Skateboards
  - Rollerblades
  - Bikes
  - Thermos Bottles or Coolers
  - Soliciting
  - Firearms \ Dangerous Weapons
  - Lasers
  - Glass bottles or cans
- **Permitted:** Juice boxes, Plastic bottles, Snacks, ETC.
- Children ages 14 years and younger must be accompanied by a paying adult when entering and exiting the facility. Children are not allowed to exit the facility without an adult.
- At end of nights racing event, please remain seated and staff member will dismiss sections of grandstands at a time due to COVID-19 guidelines.
- Smoking is Prohibited in the Main Grandstand Area.

## **Paddock Area:**

- Coolers will be allowed with haulers, but will be opened for a NON-contact inspection.
- Children 17 years of age and younger MUST be accompanied by a paying adult at ALL times.
- To enter the Pit\Paddock Area, Shoes and shirts must be worn. Shorts, Flip-Flops, and open toed shoes are Prohibited.
- The Paddock Area is restricted to persons involved in the preparation and maintenance of vehicles in competition. The paddock area is not a spectator area. Children under the age of 17 years must have a signed waiver prior to entering paddock\pit area.
- 6 foot social distancing will be in effect.
