2023 New London Waterford Speedbowl Tire Policy

All tire credits expire each week. There is no banking of tires, no credits are carried over if not used.

Tires are assigned to the driver when purchased. In some cases, a race team/car owner may request to have tires assigned to their car when they have multiple drivers during the season. Any tires purchased will be assigned to the car owner in that situation. These will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

All tires must be purchased at the racetrack. To receive a tire coupon, you must be registered as a driver, signed in for the event with your car on property participating in the day's event.

Tire purchase Limits as of 9/3/23 for a drivers first event are as follows:

SK Modified®/Late Model/SK Light:	6 Tires
Trucks/Street Stocks/Mini Stocks:	4 Tires

Competitors can add used tires to bring their total beginning inventory to 8 tires.

Any competitor who purchased tires (4) on 4/22/23 but has not competed yet this season will be able to purchase the balance of their divisions allotment as listed above.

Weekly Tire Purchase Limits are as follows:

SK Modified®/Late Model:	2 Tires
SK Lights/Trucks/Street Stocks/Mini Stocks	1 Tire

Competitors may substitute "used" tires in place of new tires.

Hoosier Tire East does not sell tires directly to race teams. All tires must be purchased at the racetrack. Hoosier Tire does not accept used tires at the racetrack. All competitors must take their tires when they leave the racetrack each week. Teams who leave tires at the racetrack will incur fines and/or penalties.

Chemical treating or altering of tires is not permitted. All tires must be considered identifiable. Tire properties must match those of the manufacturer's benchmark. NLWS Officials may confiscate and/or impound tires at any time for inspection.

Tire policies are subject to change based on availability. Weekly limits may be adjusted based on extra distance events, etc.
